Run-On Sentence:

Corrected:

Uncle Abdul drives a truck. He drives all over the state.

Run-On Sentence:

Aunt Raisa loves to bowl, she has won many contests.

Corrected:

Aunt Raisa loves to bowl. She has won many contests.
