Problem: Pepita does not like having to talk twice.

Possible Solutions	Pros (+) and Cons (-)
1. Stop speaking Spanish.	<p>(+) You wouldn't have to talk twice for people anymore.</p> <p>(-) You wouldn't be able to talk with <u>people who speak only Spanish.</u></p>
2. Stop speaking English.	<p>(+) You wouldn't have to talk twice for <u>people anymore.</u></p> <p>(-) You wouldn't be able to talk with people <u>who speak only English.</u></p>
3. Get mad and point out that you don't have time to speak twice.	<p>(+) <u>People would stop asking you to talk twice.</u></p> <p>(-) <u>You would probably lose a lot of friends.</u></p>
4. Politely say that you can't speak twice when you don't have time.	<p>(+) <u>Most people would probably stop asking you to talk twice.</u></p> <p>(+) <u>You could still talk with people who speak only Spanish or English.</u></p>
