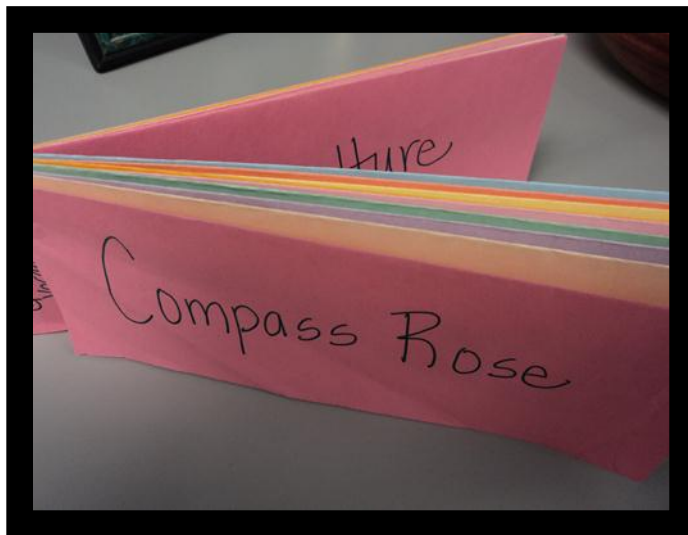

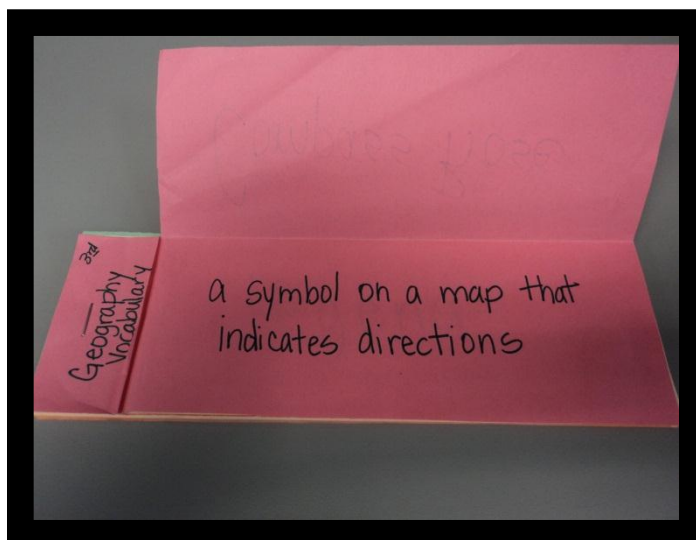
Constructing the Sentence Strip Fold

1. Cut regular 8 ½" X 11" sheets of paper in half. You will need a half sheet for each vocabulary word.
2. Fold each half sheet in half
3. Line up the left edge of all of your pieces and staple
4. Lift up the front flap of each strip and cut up about 1" away from left edge... This will allow the flap to move independently.
5. Do this with each of the strips.

Terms:

Compass Rose – a symbol on a map that indicates directions

Legend – a table or chart on a map listing and explaining the symbols used

Scale – a diagram that explains distances on a map

Topography – detailed, precise description of the terrain of a place or region

Climate – temperature, air pressure, humidity, precipitation, sunshine, cloudiness and wind....over time

Economy – the way people in a community use resources to meet their needs and wants

Region – a large land area that has geographic, political, or cultural characteristics that distinguish it from others

Geography – the study of the natural and human features of Earth's surface, its climate and life-forms

Geographer – a social scientist who studies the natural and human features of Earth's surface, its climate and life-forms

Agriculture – the business of growing crops and raising animals

Manufactured – the making of goods or materials on a large scale

Political features – borders of a country or state

Physical features – features of land, water and sky

Mass production – a way of making large quantities of products

Navigable – deep enough and wide enough for ships to use
