

# Avoiding Double Negatives

**Example A:** The photographer did not see no bears that day.

Correct:

*The photographer did not see any bears that day.*

or

*The photographer saw no bears that day.*

**Example B:** The bear wasn't doing nothing but eating berries.

**Example C:** A grizzly in early spring has not eaten nothing for months.

# Avoiding Double Negatives

**Example A:** The photographer did not see no bears that day.

Correct:

*The photographer did not see any bears that day.*

or

*The photographer saw no bears that day.*

**Example B:** The bear wasn't doing nothing but eating berries.

The bear was doing nothing but eating berries.

The bear wasn't doing anything but eating berries.

**Example C:** A grizzly in early spring has not eaten nothing for months.
