

## MAP Skills Checklist Assessments

Listed by approximate level of difficulty, easy to hard

All assessments are auditory. Children use headphones. Check computer beforehand to make sure sound is “on” and not on “mute”.

1. **Letter Identification** - both upper and lowercase, 52 questions
2. **Phonics:** Matching Letters to Sounds - consonants and short vowel sounds, 31 questions
3. **Phonological Awareness** - rhyming, identifying number of syllables (called word parts), blending sounds to make a word, 35 questions
4. **Phonemic Awareness:** Phoneme Identification – initial and final consonants, middle vowel sounds (listen carefully, can be tricky choosing the correct picture), 44 questions
5. **Phonemic Awareness:** Manipulation of Sounds – blending of sounds, substituting sounds at beginning, middle, and end of words, deletion of sounds (can be tricky, listen to question more than one time to be sure you heard correctly), 35 questions
6. **Decoding:** Spelling Patterns/Word Families – 18 word families assessed, 18 questions
7. **Syllable Types:** CVC, CVCe, R-controlled vowels, 14 questions
8. **Decoding:** Consonant Blends/Digraphs – both initial and final assessed, 47 questions
9. **Syllable Types:** Vowel Digraphs/Diphthongs – common vowel combinations assessed, 21 questions
10. **Decoding:** Multi-Syllable Words, Affixes, Open and closed with le – inflectional endings, prefixes, suffixes, open and closed syllables with le (includes choosing correct spelling), 30 questions

These are appropriate for any student that you need additional information on their early literacy skills. It is easier to print results immediately after the “Good Dog” than going to the NWEA site later to print results. Use Control-Shift-K and select Print Results.
