ORAL READING FLUENCY PASSAGE

The Little Tan Kitten

★A little tan kitten went into the den. 8

His dad said, "Sit still. There is a rat." 17

The kitten said, "Look! I see two rats!" 25

The rats said, "We hear two cats." 32

Then the rats ran and hid. 38

ORAL READING FLUENCY

Start timing at the ★. Mark errors. Make a single slash (/) at 60 seconds. Have student complete passage. If the student completes the passage in less than 60 seconds, have the student go back to the ★ and continue reading. Make a double slash (//) in the text at 60 seconds.

WCPM STRONG PASS

Determine words correct per minute by subtracting errors from words read in 60 seconds. The student scores no more than 2 errors on the first pass through the passage and reads a minimum of 49 or more words correct per minute. Proceed to Unit 22.

WEAK PASS

The student scores no more than 2 errors on the first pass through the passage and reads 38 to 48 words correct per minute. Proceed to Unit 22 with added fluency practice, or provide Extra Practice lessons in Unit 21, and/or provide a Jell-Well Review.

NO PASS

The student scores 3 or more errors on the first pass through the passage and/or reads 37 or fewer words correct per minute. Provide Extra Practice lessons and retest, and/or provide a Jell-Well Review.
