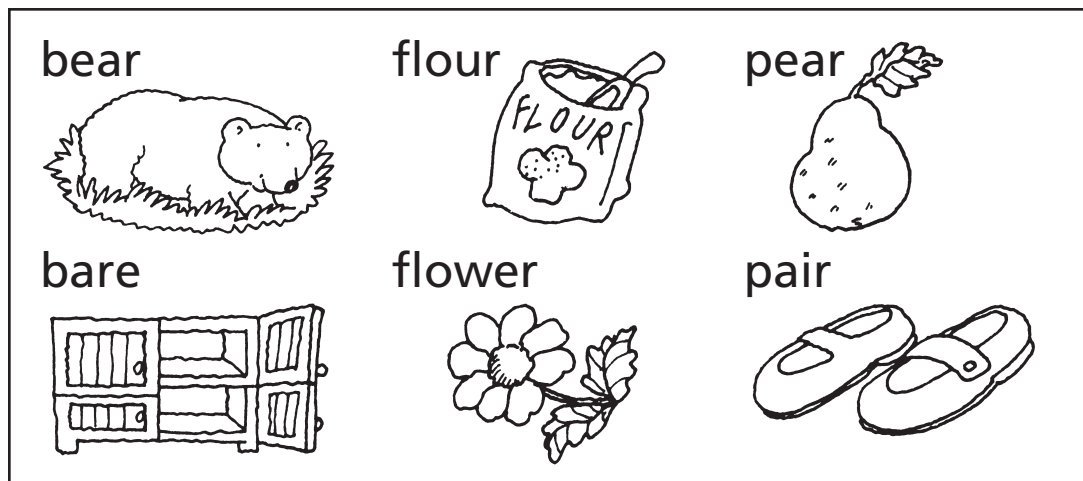


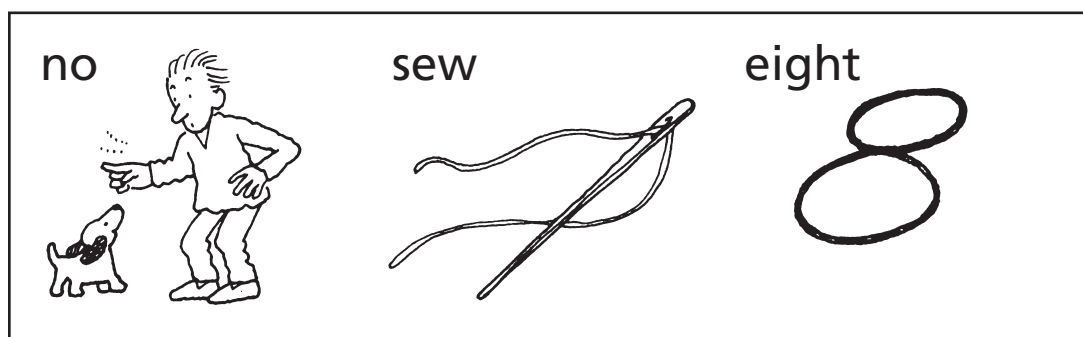
Words that Sound Alike



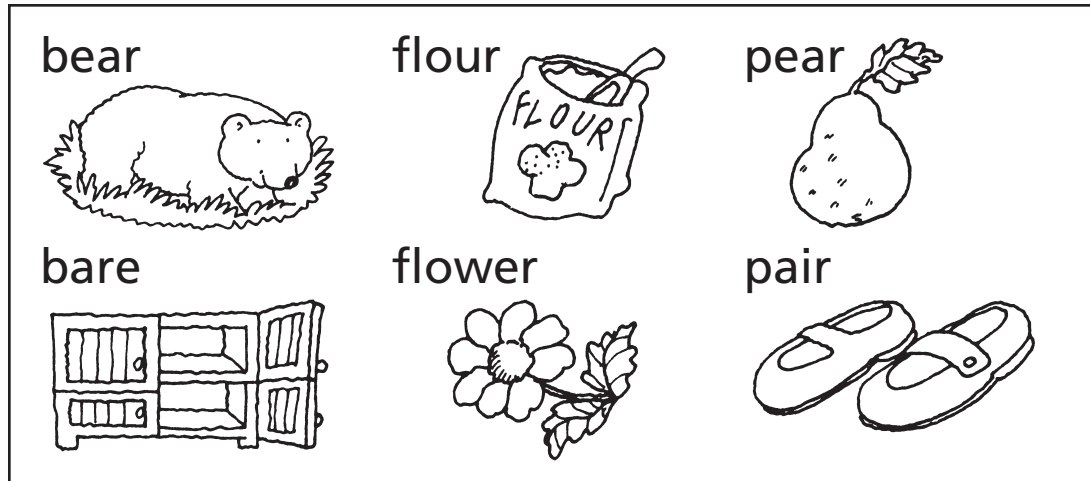
Example:
