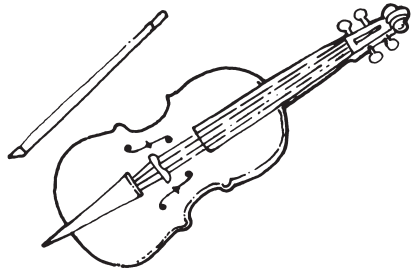
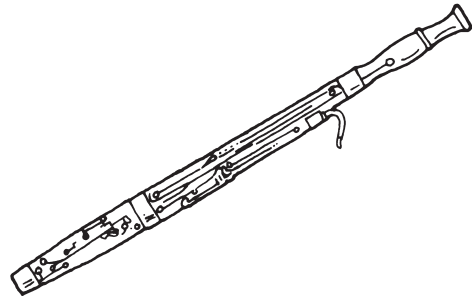

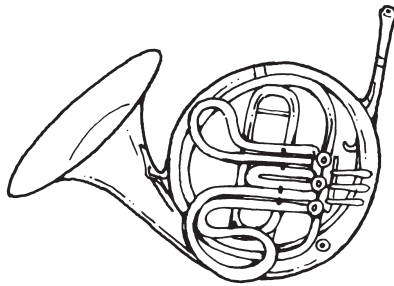
Musical Instruments



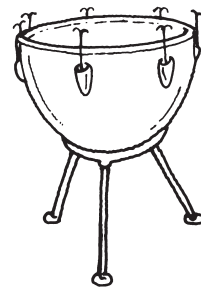
The cello is a stringed instrument shaped like a violin, only much larger. The long pin at the bottom of the cello rests on the floor.



The bassoon is a wind instrument. To play it, a musician blows into the crook, a small curved pipe that sticks out on the side of the bassoon.



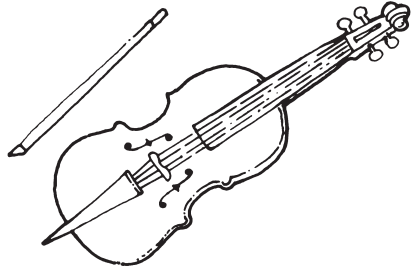
The French horn is a brass instrument. The horn is a twelve-foot metal tube coiled into a round shape.



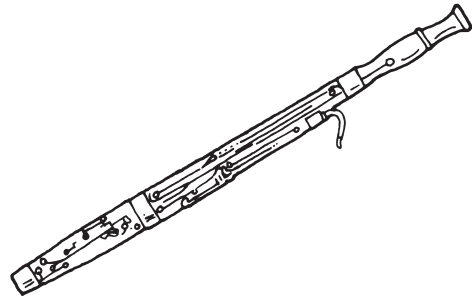

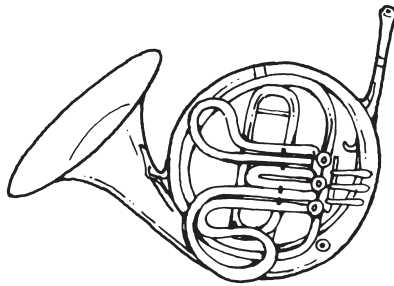

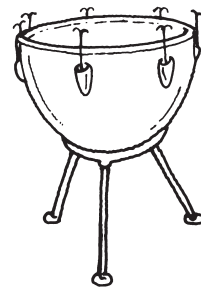
