Long ago, Pele did not live in Hawaii. She lived with her mother, father, brothers, and sisters. Pele would get mad at them and send hot melted rock into the sea.

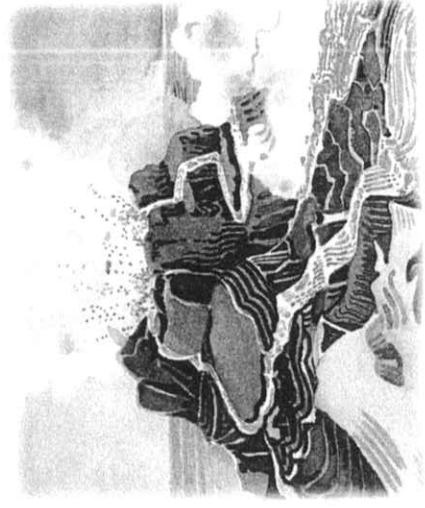
The people say that Pele's brother the shark god took Pele away. When Pele and her brother got to the island of Hawaii, Pele said, "This will be my land."

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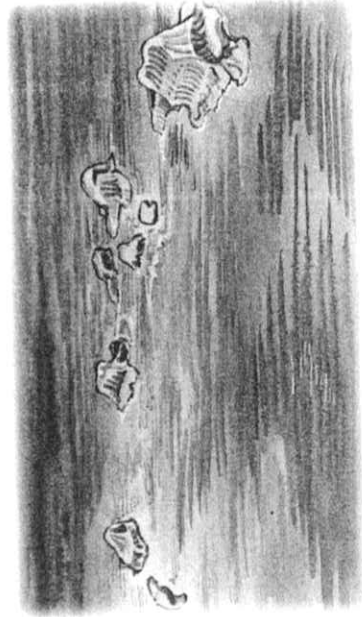

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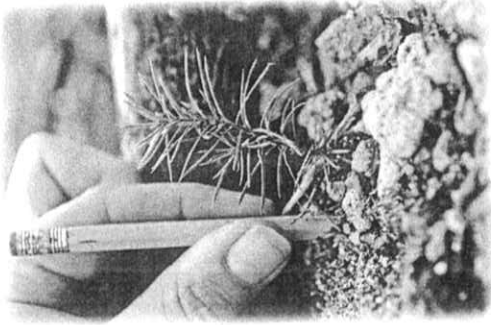
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After the Volcano Blast
