Come Again Another Day

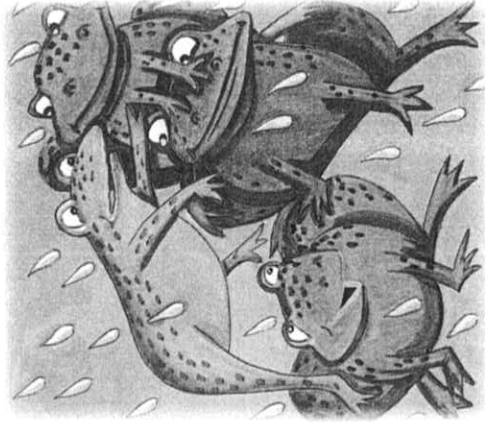
The people expected an afternoon shower. However, when the rain started to fall, it was more than just a shower. People asked, "What is happening?"

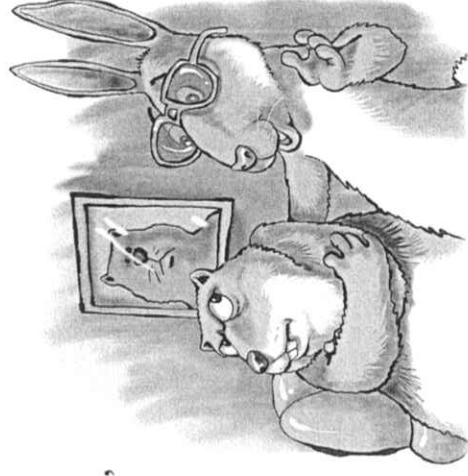
A Foolish Fear
