Portrait of a Grad

- Kelly Ott, Exec. Dir. of Curriculum. & Innovation & Instruction, the work that has been done to support the BV Blueprint Health & Wellbeing goal to develop the qualities of a Blue Valley graduate. Input has been gathered from nearly 500 people from across our school community regarding qualities that encompass both academic and social emotional success, as well as the visual representation of a final product. The Portrait of a Grad is a strategic response to the changing world and experiences that students are having and will have after graduation. It will represent the WHY of the work we do to ensure Blue Valley students are prepared for post-secondary experiences, including college, career and life. The committee provided input that was collected to be included in the final product.

Social Emotional Learning

- Sondra Wallace, Dir. of Student Support Services, shared the work that is being done to support the BV Blueprint Health & Wellbeing goal of clarity & capacity of SEL for all. The CASEL framework is the BV Framework and includes five competencies (Self-Awareness, Self-Management, Social Awareness, Responsible Decision Making & Relationship Skills) that are aligned to the KS Social Emotional and Character Development Standards. Each of the competencies include several specific skills that are taught K-12 in all content areas through embedded curriculum, intentional lesson design and direct instruction to ensure guaranteed and viable Social Emotional Learning for all Blue Valley students. The committee asked about the qualities that were discussed for the Portrait of a Grad and if this work will align and support those efforts. Sondra shared that the work would be aligned for a consistent vision across the district.
